RANGs: Bill Georgina

We played **29 rang games** in 2022 -2 in May, 8 in June, 7 in July, 8 in August and 4 in September. 3 games were "Rained out" and we had a Scramble on June 27th.

RANG games cost \$ 2.00 per game, and although we need your money up front to ensure you are in the RANG game before play, you only get charged the \$ 2.00 for each game you actually play. If you can't make it for some reason, then your money simply rolls over for a future game.

Since most golfers do miss some games the amount of money owing at any time can get confusing. The number of Rang games each person has played is the major determinant.

The final Rang payouts will be adjusted to refund any overpayments, as well as recovering any amounts still due.

207 Rangs were awarded in 2022 (269 Rangs were won in 2021) and \$ **1,449.00** in Rang money was awarded at the Seniors Closing Banquet.

Gordie Eisan won the 50-50 draw worth \$ 131.50


CLUB TOURNAMENTS:
