<u>Memorials</u>: On behalf of our Senior League, we made Memorial donations in memory of *past members* Dexter Power, Earl Nicol and Paul Curran.

<u>Restaurant</u>: The restaurant did not open from Monday to Wednesday until mid-July, and was frequently closed on other days.

South Course: RO's new management announced they will not be reopening the South Course

<u>RAIN/FLOODING</u>: In 2023 River Oaks experienced unprecedented rain and flooding due to climate change. As a result we missed 8 of our scheduled Rang games. The course had to close many other days, and we were only able to play 15 holes for most of August.

<u>FIRE Donation</u>: Due to the wildfires nearby, we decided to donate the Senior League's share of June's 50-50 draw to the Red Cross, to aid in our wildfire relief. We raised \$ 668.00 that month, (which included a 48.00 additional donation from Larry and Pat Ward) So, the Senior League was able to donate \$ **348.00** to the Red Cross.

Our \$ 348.00 donation

was tripled by matching contributions from the Provincial and Federal government so the Red Cross received **\$** 1,044.00 as a result.

RANGs: Bill Georgina

RAIN in 2023 washed out 8 Rang games. We played **28 rang games** in 2023 -4 in May,5 in June, 5 in July, 8 in August and 6 in September.

RANG games cost \$ 2.00 per game, and although we need your money up front to ensure you are in the RANG game before play, you only get charged the \$ 2.00 for each game you actually play. If you can't make it for some reason, then your money simply rolls over for a future game.

Since most golfers do miss some games the amount of money owing at any time can get confusing. The number of Rang games each person has played is the major determinant.

The final Rang payouts are adjusted to refund any overpayments, as well as recovering any amounts still due.

180 Rangs were awarded in 2023 (207 Rangs were won in 2022) and **\$ 1260.00** in Rang money was awarded at the Seniors Closing Banquet. (also, 973.00 was refunded in rang money that was overpaid)
